

The Wall of Migrants

The Wall of Migrants, symbol of past migrations in the 19th and 20th centuries, pays tribute to these men and women, to their courage and determination, to chart a new destiny for them and their families by emigrating to other countries. The names of our migrant ancestors are engraved on a plaque affixed and visible on the physical Wall, complemented by a digital Wall, making their individual stories accessible online.

After 84 first migrants on 21 plates, the 3rd batch is now opened to add new plates!

A lot of work to follow for the coming months:

- The gradual online publication of the missing biographies of the 84 migrants, in 3 languages!
- Sending a certificate of registration with the photo of the plate to each subscriber.
- The installation of solar light points above the physical Wall to illuminate it at night.
- The installation of signage at the entrance of San Domenico stairs.
