## **Births and deaths on merchant navy ships, disappearances and deaths for France at sea (1859-1993)**

For your ancestors born or deceased at sea, as sailors or passengers, find on the website of the National Archives an interesting inventory with online registers:

The first set consists of summary registers of **deaths and births on merchant navy ships** or fishing vessels, known as "merchant navy civil status".

The second set consists of registers mentioning the identity of **persons who have disappeared at sea** during a sea voyage.

The third type of register contains the list of decisions to grant and refuse the mention "**Died for France**" of seafarers or persons who died at sea.
